
Please take the opportunity to chat with Michelle when you see her around the theatre. I'm sure you'll agree with the Board and me that we've acquired a gem!

Director's Notes

When I first considered directing *Two Guvs* I browsed through a few reviews. One reviewer declared, "If you're not having a good time at this show, you may be on the wrong medication." Immediately, I knew this was the show for me.

Nicholas Hytner, the Director of England's National Theatre, was intrigued with the prospect of adapting Carlo Goldini's play *A Servant of Two Masters* from its Commedia dell'Arte setting in 18th Century Italy to Brighton in 1963. He collaborated with Richard Bean, an award winning playwright, and composer/musician Grant Olding to create a world of skiffle bands, early Beatles music, and peculiarly English slapstick/music hall humor. *One Man, Two Guvnors* opened at The National Theatre in 2011, then went on to great acclaim on the West End and Broadway. Olding called his skiffle band The Craze – a pun on *The Krays*, the sinister twin brothers who once ruled the London underworld. Our band has a much more West Coast feel – The Salty Ouips.

Commedia dell'Arte sprang from improvised set pieces, Lazzi, that were concerned with intrigues among servants and masters. Stock characters such as Pantolone, Il Dottore, Arlechinno, Columbina and Pulcinella, capered and tumbled to the delight of their audiences. These stock characters are easily found in the works of Shakespeare, Moliere, The Marx Brothers and The Simpsons. British comedy adapted Commedia characters into Punch and Judy shows on beaches, Christmas pantomimes, the slapstick comedy of Charlie Chaplin, Norman Wisdom, Morcambe and Wise, and the Carry On series of films.

So check your meds and have a good laugh.
