About the Playwright



CAROLE FRÉCHETTE Author

Carole Fréchette was born in Montreal in 1949, and there attended the National Theatre School. Upon graduating, she joined *Théatre des cuisines* (Kitchen Theatre Group) in 1974, developing her interests in Marxist and feminist theatre and collective arts production. Since her first play, *Baby Blues*, was staged in 1989, Fréchette's work has been produced the world over and translated into over twenty languages;

she is also known for her children's novels and translations. Fréchette's *Les Quatre Morts de Marie* won the 1995 Governor General's Award for Drama, and *La Petite pièce en haut de l'escalier (The Small Room at the Top of the Stairs*, in its original French) earned her a nomination for France's *Grand Prix de littérature dramatique* in 2009. Her diverse catalogue includes *Les sept jours de Simon Labrosse, Violette sur la terre, Jean et Béatrice*, and most recently *Je pense à Yu*. Fréchette has been lauded for her support of francophone and Quebecois theatre, which has included presidency of the *Centre des auteurs dramatiques*.



JOHN MURRELL Translator

Born in Texas in 1945, John Murrell moved to Canada in 1969, where he earned a teaching diploma in drama from the University of Calgary. He is a prolific playwright, whose works include *Memoir, Farther West, New World, The Faraway Nearby, Democracy*, and *October*. Murrell has worked as playwright-in-residence with Theatre Calgary, as associate director of the Stratford Festival of Canada, as head of the

Banff Playwrights Colony, and as head of the theatre section of the Canada Council for the Arts. In 2003, he was appointed an officer of the Order of Canada, and he holds an honorary doctor of laws degree from the University of Calgary. In addition to *The Small Room at the Top of the Stairs*, John Murrell is responsible for the English translations of Frechette's other works, *The Four Lives of Marie, Seven Days in the life of Simon Labrosse, Elisa's Skin, Helen's Necklace, John and Beatrice, Earthbound*, and *Thinking of Yu*. He has garnered international repute for his translations of Chekhov, Ibsen, Sophocles, and Cocteau.


MICHELLE MORRIS Anne

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
