

He subsequently attended the Julliard School for playwrighting and started producing plays shortly after. Proof opened in 2000 and won both the Tony award for best play and the Pulitzer Prize for Drama. Since then he has written plays, adapted and written screenplays and directed for the theatre in New York.




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
