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GRILLED GREMOLATA-STUFFED SARDINES

Yield: serves 5-7

Ingredients

- 1/3 cup olive oil
- 1/4 cup minced parsley
- 1/4 cup minced thyme
- 20 cloves garlic, minced
- Zest of 2 lemons, plus wedges for serving
- Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste
- 16 fresh sardines, cleaned, rinsed, and dried

Instructions

Stir oil, parsley, thyme, garlic, zest, salt, and pepper in a bowl. Stuff each sardine with about 1 tbsp. garlic mixture.

Heat a charcoal grill or set a gas grill to high. (Alternatively, heat a cast-iron grill pan over medium-high heat.) Grill sardines, flipping once, until slightly charred and cooked through, 4–6 minutes.

Serve with lemon wedges.




